Dr. Alex Valcke is Vice President, Innovation, of Arch Chemicals, Inc. (NYSE: ARJ), a global Biocides company with annual sales of over \$1 billion. Dr. Valcke joined Arch in November 2009 after a 25-year career at Janssen Pharmaceutica NV (part of the Johnson & Johnson family of companies), where he most recently held the position of General Manager, Preservation and Material Protection Division. During his career at Janssen, he gained valuable experience as a business leader, managed key divestments and acquisitions for the division, and led a successful effort to significantly expand the company's new product portfolio. He also is an inventor and co-inventor for several patents in the field of material protection biocides and has extensive experience in technology licensing.

Dr. Valcke graduated from the University of Ghent in Belgium in 1978 with a specialty focus in microbiology, forestry engineering and wood technology. He subsequently earned his Ph.D. in Bio-engineering sciences from the University of Ghent in 1985 and obtained an additional Management Education from the Vlerick Management School at the University of Ghent in 1995. Among his many professional associations and accomplishments, he held senior-level positions at the International Research Group on Wood Preservation, where he became the first person from industry to be elected president.
