- 1» Did you know that the BAQUACIL® Pool Care system not only protects swimmers against a wide variety of bacteria, but it will also allow swimsuits to maintain their original color throughout the season?
- 2» Did you know BAQUACIL CDX™ helps maintain the BAQUACIL Oxidizer level in your pool?
- 3» Did you know that BAQUACIL Surface Cleaner will remove metal stains, oil, scale and dirt both above and below the waterline? And it's also chlorine compatible.
- 4» Did you know that cleaning your spa's cover should be a part of your maintenance routine? It's easy with BaquaSpa® Cover Cleaner, an effective way to clean dirt and other deposits to prevent unnecessary deterioration of spa covers.
- 5» Did you know that swishing a test strip back and forth may compromise the accuracy of the test? It is better to dip the strip for one second, remove it from the water and then hold it level for 15 seconds. It is also ideal to compare the test strip to the color comparator in direct sunlight, not in artificial light.
- 6» Did you know it is a good idea to bring a water sample to your authorized dealer for analysis purposes? They will be able to tell you the exact water-balance adjustment you need in order to get your pool or spa in perfect condition.
- 7» Did you know that even with an automatic pool cleaner, you should still brush the bottom and sides of your pool every week? This routine will help reduce buildup and the growth of algae.
- 8» Did you know that when water is corrosive, metals can be eroded from any exposed metal surfaces? To prevent this problem, keep water balanced by maintaining the proper pH, alkalinity and calcium levels.
- 9» Did you know that odor and taste problems may be a result of excessively high chemical levels or the buildup of contaminants? Consult with your authorized dealer to ensure that your water balance, sanitizer levels and oxidation procedures are optimized.
- 10» Did you know you should clean debris from the skimmer and hair and lint strainer basket, as well as the pool, as needed, to allow water to filter at optimum efficiency?
