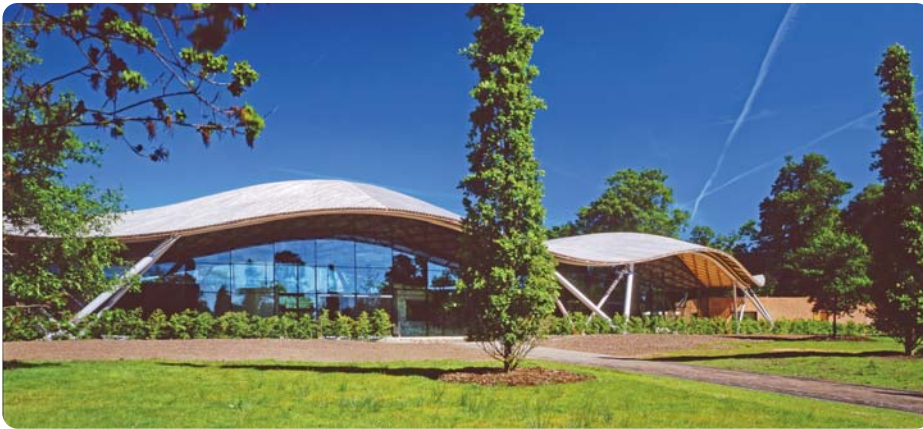


The Savill Building, The Royal Landscape, 2006.
