Interesting Facts:

**During the construction phase in 2006, the Pagoda suffered an arson attack:**

- The spread of the fire was limited to 75% of the lower deck flooring and supporting joists.
- Due to the DRICON fire retardant treatment, the fire self-extinguished and prevented the entire project being razed to the ground, with construction costs in excess of £200,000.
- Despite the wanton act of vandalism, the project continued to completion with minimal cost outlay.
- This real-life fire test demonstrates the effectiveness of the treatment, negating the required attendance of the fire services.
