## TANALISED<sup>®</sup> CONTRACTORS PROGRAM

### Terms and Conditions:

1. In using the numbered contractor's stamp on their invoices, contractors will be passing on the **Tanalised<sup>®</sup> Lifetime Guarantee** to their customers.
2. Any claims that arise from customers will be subject to the terms and conditions of the **Tanalised<sup>®</sup> Lifetime Guarantee** as contained in the **Tanalised<sup>®</sup> Lifetime Guarantee** brochure and on [www.tanalised.com/sa](http://www.tanalised.com/sa).
3. This guarantee only applies to treated poles and timber that have the **TAN<sup>™</sup>** mark. This will be in the form of an ink stamp on sawn timber and be found on the anti-split plate on gum poles and the metal disk on pine poles. In all these instances the **TAN<sup>™</sup>** mark will form part of the treatment certification marking.
4. Contractors need to make sure that treated timber or poles are used according to the correct hazard class classification as marked on the timber and poles.
5. In using the stamp on their invoices, contractors need to make sure that:
  - i. the treated timber or pole products were purchased from an approved **Tanalised<sup>®</sup>** dealer, and
  - ii. all the timber and poles have the **TAN<sup>™</sup>** mark
6. Contractors and their customers understand that the **Tanalised<sup>®</sup> Lifetime Guarantee** is a replacement guarantee on the timber or poles rendered structurally unserviceable.
7. Should parties not abide by the terms and conditions, they will not be able to participate in the **Tanalised<sup>®</sup> Lifetime Guarantee** program.
